



University of California, Riverside Bridge to the Doctorate Fellowships are Available for AY 2007-2008!

UC Riverside seeks to broaden the pool of undergraduate students who enter doctoral programs by encouraging ethnically underrepresented students to pursue graduate degrees and careers in science, engineering and mathematics (SEM). Funded by the National Science Foundation (NSF), Bridge to the Doctorate awards are open to alumni of Louis Stokes Alliances for Minority Participation (LSAMP) programs who accept admission to a graduate program at UC Riverside for the Fall 2007 term.

PROGRAM PROVISIONS

Fellowship funding for first 2 years of graduate study (ca. **\$30,000 / year**), followed by TA/RA funding for up to 5 years total.

Full graduate school tuition and fee support

Academic year/summer research experiences

Professional conference & research travel opportunities

Monthly professional development seminars

Networking opportunities with graduate students across SEM disciplines

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Past/Present participant in an undergraduate LSAMP, AMP, or CAMP Program

Must meet UC Riverside's graduate admissions requirements

Acceptance into a UCR Science, Engineering, or Mathematics Graduate Program
